Creative and Artistic Students

: If you love exploring new artistic techniques, experimenting with various mediums, and pushing your creative boundaries, IB Visual Arts is for you.

Aspiring Art School Students:

Planning to apply to art school or pursue a creative career? This course will help you build an impressive portfolio while preparing you for higher education.

*Not everyone in this course wants to go to art school - this course can be for those wanting to balance their timetable or just love making art!

Innovative Problem-Solvers:

This course goes beyond technical skills, encouraging students to think critically, solve problems, and engage with art on a deeper level.

Global Citizens:

IB Visual Art connects art with global cultures, social issues, and different perspectives. If you're interested in exploring the world through art, this course provides a unique platform for cultural understanding.



COURSE OVERVIEW

Studio Work:

Experiment with multiple art forms such as painting, sculpture, photography, digital media, and installation art. Projects vary from technical skill-building to creative, independent works.

Artist Research:

Dive deep into the study of artists, both historical and contemporary, from a variety of cultural backgrounds. You'll explore how different mediums and methods contribute to artmaking and apply these findings to your own work

Personal Portfolio Development:

Create a personal portfolio to present your growth as an artist. You'll work on both individual and collaborative projects while documenting your artistic process through journals and research



Process Portfolio:

A core part of the course, the process portfolio showcases your experimentation with various art-making techniques and forms. It includes reflections, technical skill development, and exploration of different artistic concepts.

Comparative Study:

A comparative study of artists from different cultural contexts is required. You'll explore how three works of art compare in design, concept and execution. HL students compare their own work as well and reflect on the artistic influences and methods adopted in your personal projects.

Exhibition:

In their final year, students will curate and present a personal exhibition showcasing a collection of resolved works. This exhibition reflects their growth, artistic vision, and technical skills, and is assessed as part of their final IB grade.



Pursuing the IB Diploma?

This is a group 6 course and can be used as your 6th option to complete your IB Diploma.

Not in IB? That's no problem!

Students can register in JUST the IB Art 11 course without taking any other IB courses. You just need a referral from your Art 9 or 10 teacher for the application process. Credits count for graduation!
